

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1090

WHEREAS, Articles of Association and By-Laws of the East Chuichu Project to form a local non-profit cooperative association without capital stock, have been presented to the Papago Tribal Council for approval, and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council feels the establishment of this association may be a good thing for the individuals who become members of it, and that the Articles of Association and By-laws are satisfactory.

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the Articles of Association and By-Laws of the East Chuichu Project be approved.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on January 8, 1960, with a vote of 20 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3 (g) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). The Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
