## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1092

WHEREAS, On May 1, 1959, the Papago Council duly passed Resolution No. 1050 approving the Amendment to the Attorneys' Contract with Marks & Marks, covering expenses in connection with claims work, as extending the term of the original contract; and

WHEREAS, Said Resolution failed to include in it the authorization of the Chairman and Secretary of the Papago Council to execute said Amendment to the Attorneys' Contract,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council in meeting assembled this 8th day of January, 1960, that the Chairman and Secretary, respectively, of the Papago Council are authorized and instructed to execute the Amendment to the Attorneys' Contract, and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this authorization shall be retroactive to the 31 day of July, 1959, the date that the Chairman and Secretary executed said Contract.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 8, 1960, duly enacted by a vote of 20 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) & (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
