RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1094

WHEREAS, Jones and Trotz, contractors on the new Kitt Peak Road, have made an application for a camp site of approximately 4 acres next to the Right of Way where the Kitt Peak Road begins, this compsite to be used to locate their office facilities, trailers for living quarters, and other campaite installations, plus space for equipment storage and repair facilities, and

WHEREAS, the contractor has agreed to pay \$50.00 per acre per year for the campsite as required by Ordinance 15, which will amount to \$400.00 for the 2 years it will take to build the road, and onehalf of the money received will go to Schuk Toak District and onehalf to the Tribal Council in accordance with the constitution, and

WHEREAS, Salavadore Lopez and Albert Martinez, tribal council delegates from Schuk Toak District have considered this request and approved it, and have asked Mr. Higman, Adm. Asst., to come to the District meeting on January 17, so it can be explained to the District Council and a District Resolution be prepared for approval and signature.

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it approve the request of Jones and Trotz for a camp site, subject to the approval of the Schuk Took District Council, and that it request the Papago Agency to issued the necessary permit for the camp site.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 8, 1960, duly enacted by a vote of 20 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
