PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, The Bac Livestock Association has presented the following budget for the 1960 calendar year to the Papago Tribal Council for its approval:

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council believes this budget to be a reasonable one.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the budget for the 1960 calendar year of the Bac Livestock Association be approved.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on March 4, 1960, with a vote of 21 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3 (h) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the Rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
