

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1145

WHEREAS, Willard Juan Chiago, a full blooded Papago is on the 1937 official tribal roll No. 869, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Chiago is now in the U. S. Air Force in Louisiana, but is planning to return to the Reservation after he retires from the service, and

WHEREAS, Willard Chiago is 4/4 Papago, and his wife, Ingeburg S. Chiago is 4/4 German, which makes his daughter Christina Agnes Chiago, who was born off the Reservation, 1/2 Papago, and

WHEREAS, Willard Chiago has made a request for his daughter, Christina Agnes, to be adopted as a member of the Tribe, which can be done by the Council in accordance with Article II of the Constitution, which provides that: Article II Section 1 (b)

The Council shall have power to adopt all children born outside of the Reservation, who are the offspring of members, and are one-half or more Indian blood.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED By the Papago Tribal Council that it adopt Christina Agnes Chiago as a member of the Papago Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on January 6, 1961, with a vote of 20 for, and 0 against, 2 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article II of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
