## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1150

WHEREAS, On March 27, 1960, the San Xavier District Council passed a Resolution approving the application of Mission San Xavier del Bac for a lease on approximately 3.56 acres immediately in front of San Xavier Mission, map and description to be furnished later.

WHEREAS, The Mission wishes to lease this land so it can excavate the foundations of the old buildings that used to be situated on this land, and in time to restore the buildings, and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council believes it would be a good idea to authorize the Mission to lease the land with the hope that eventually, restoration of the buildings will improve the appearance of the Mission and people will be able to see it as it was in the early history of Arizona territory.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED By the Papago Council that it approve the application of Mission San Mavier del Bac, and that it request the Papago Agency to issue a business lease on this property for a period of 25 years with option to lease for an additional 25 years, at the rate of \$6.00 per acre or fraction thereof per year.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on March 3, 1961, with a vote of 16 for, 3 against, and 2 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
