

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1152

WHEREAS, There are 79.5 acres of land near Wall's Well, which are within the boundaries of the Papago Reservation, and patent No. 051714, dated July 22, 1922, thereon, was issued to William O. Miller. The land is described as follows:

Lot 2, and NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 10, T. 158,  
Range 4 W, G & SR meridian, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, The present owner of the land is Mr. Leo Rich, 205 North Stone Avenue, Tucson, who would like the Tribe to become owner of the land either through purchase, or exchanging it for an equivalent parcel of Federal land, and

WHEREAS, This land is inside the Reservation boundaries, it has had an indian village on it which has been in existence prior to the establishment of the Papago Reservation, and also has a well which can be used to water indian livestock; therefore, the Tribal Council believes it would be of great benefit to the Tribe if the land were acquired for them. However, it does not have adequate tribal funds for this purpose, so must look to the Bureau of Indian Affairs if the land is to be acquired.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY The Papago Tribal Council that it petition the Bureau of Indian Affairs to acquire the above described parcel of land for the Tribe either by purchase or exchange of equivalent Federal land and that steps be initiated in this direction as soon as possible.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on March 3, 1961, with a vote of 18 for, 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
