

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1154

WHEREAS, Hickiwan District Council has approved a budget in the amount of \$850.00 for Charco 27 and Gunsight Villages to be spent as follows:

Hay	\$200.00
Gas and Oil	150.00
Pasture	100.00
Corral	100.00
Groceries	<u>300.00</u>
	\$850.00

WHEREAS, According to terms of the Resolution passed by the Hickiwan District Council for fiscal year 1960, these two villages actually only have \$812.75 for their use.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED By the Papago Tribal Council that it approve a budget of only \$812.75 for Charco 27 and Gunsight Villages in Hickiwan District, and that any additional amount will have to be reconsidered and approved by the district.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on March 3, 1961, with a vote of 18 for, and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
