RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

HES. NO. 1155

WHEREAS, On February 10, 1961, the Gu Achi District Council passed the attached Resolution concerning Mr. Dean Saxton, and

WHORIAS, The Tribal Council believes a district is the best judge of whether non-members should be removed or excluded from the district, and

WHEREAS, The Resolution bassed by the Gu Achi District Council indicates the District Council believes Mr. Saxton's presence in the district is injurious to the beace, happiness, and welfare of members of the Tribe.

THEREFORM, LET IT BE RESCLVED By the Papago Tribal Council that it approve the attached Resolution passed by the Gu Achi District Council, requesting Mr. Dean Saxton and his family to leave Santa Rosa Community in Gu Achi District, and be it further resolved that the Tribal Council also ask Mr. Saxton and his family to leave.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on March 3, 1961, with a vote of 15 for, 0 against, and 3 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was protent, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (c) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
