RESQUULION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RESCRIPTION SO. 1157

Whereas, At the time it recommended approval of the application of Hunting Desphysical Services, Inc., for a reservation-wide prospecting permit with outlon to lease, the Council withdrew two areas from the proposed application, one of which is the area east of Santa Ross Lash in the following townships:

T.S., R.S., T.S., R.E., T. 95, R.45, T. 95., R.5E; TIOS. R.S. TIOS, R.45,

Whereas, The reason the area was withdrawn is because there has been recent active interest by mining companies in this particular area and therefore the Council did not feel it should be included in the application made by Hunting Coophysical Services, Inc., and

Whereas, The Utah Psyclopsont Company has recently made an application for a prespecting permit with option to lease in part of the area that has been withdrawn, Pholps-Dedge Corporation has also expressed active interest in mart of the area, and Trans-Arizona Resources, Inc., who operate the Lake Shore Mine, have indicated they want an opportunity to be considered if lensing is being proposed, and

Whereas, The Tribal Council has expressed itself that it hepes the present application of Munting Geophysical Services can be regotiated on that part of the Reservation not withdrawn by the Council, but it believes that in view of the interest being shown, it would be desirable to ask that advertisement be made for bids in the withdrawn area.

Therefore, Let it be Resolved by the Papago Tribal Council that the Sureau of Indian Affairs be requested to advertise an area or areas within the boundaries described above, for an exclusive prospecting serwit with option to lease, which it thinks will be best suited to secure bids which it thinks will be most favorable to the Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enseted by the Papage Council on Harch 3, 1961, with a vote of 18 for and C against, during a menting at which a quorum yas present, pursuant to authority in the Council by Article V, Section 3 (2), of the Constitution of the Papage Tribe retified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Contine 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934(Stat. 962) Said Descintion is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superinturient of the Papage Agency and is subject to reclusion by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Lane of the Papage Tribe.
