

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 1160

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council wishes to have an adequate supply of baskets on hand for sale at the annual Papago Rodeo this fall, and

WHEREAS, Purchase of these baskets should be started soon if enough are to be obtained, and

WHEREAS, Last year the Council authorized the purchase of \$1,000 worth of baskets in its Rodeo budget, all of which were sold at the Rodeo, but the Rodeo budget has not yet been determined because the Rodeo Committee appointed at this Council meeting probably will not hold a meeting for some time, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Elisabeth Estrada, who handled basket sales for the Tribe at the Rodeo last year, and who has also been approved by the Council to manage other sales of Papago baskets, has offered to start buying baskets for the Rodeo, and will be willing to store them until Rodeo time.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it authorize the expenditure of up to \$1,000 for the purchase of Papago baskets by Mrs. Elisabeth Estrada for sale at the Papago Rodeo this fall, payment to be made for the purchases upon presentation of an itemized list of baskets purchased with their prices, and signed for by Mrs. Estrada. The money for these purchases is to be taken from the Rodeo Fund account, #P-1 I, which now has a balance of 3,595.10.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on April 7, 1931, with a vote of 20 for, and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1930, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1931, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 15, 1934 (Stat. 934). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
