

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

BBB. NO. 1261

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council discussed the increasing of the salary of the Chairman of the Council at its March meeting but took no action, and

WHEREAS, The Council again considered this matter at its April meeting and decided to increase the Chairman's salary.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RECEIVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it increase the salary of the Tribal Chairman from \$270.00 per month to \$400 per month beginning April 1, 1961, it being understood that there is enough money provided in the 1960-61 fiscal year budget to cover this increase for the balance of the fiscal year.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on April 7, 1961, with a vote of 11 for, and 2 against and 7 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 19, 1934 (Stat. 934). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
