

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, on March 31, 1961 the "ickiwan District Council considered and approved an application of the U. S. Engineers to lease approximately 4 acres located in the S. E. quarter of Section 2, T. 10 S., Range 2 West, Maricopa County, the exact description to be furnished later, and

WHEREAS, the approval was granted on the basis of a letter from the U. S. Engineers to the Papago Agency, dated February 24, 1961, with the additional stipulation that approval is granted provided the U. S. Engineers pay a rental of \$50.00 per year for each ~~acre~~ or fraction thereof, the rental to be begin on the date the U. S. Engineers enter on the land, and

WHEREAS, The Council understands that these sites will be used in connection with National Defense work being done at Ft. Huachuca, and like the Rickiwan District, the Tribal Council is interested in helping national defense.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it approve the application of the U. S. Engineers in accordance with their letter of application, provided the U. S. Engineers agree to pay a yearly rental of \$50.00 per acre or fraction thereof, and that the Council request that the lease be processed with the approval of the Papago Agency.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 7, 1961, duly enacted by a vote of 20 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 15 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 934). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
