

RESOLUTION  
OF  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. No. 1167

WHEREAS, On April 21, 1961, the Chukut Kuk District Council passed a Resolution approving the deposit of Chukut Kuk District funds in savings accounts in commercial banks in Tucson that have Federal Deposit Insurance for such accounts, and

WHEREAS, The District Council wishes to deposit \$8,181.35 in one savings account, this being the amount recently withdrawn by the Agency from the Main office of the Valley National Bank because the bank and the Agency were unable to locate the pass-book for the account, and also wishes to deposit an additional sum of \$3,500 in another account, with Mr. Harry W. Gilmore, Superintendent of the Papago Agency, to be designated as Trustee of both accounts, and

WHEREAS, in a memo dated April 19, 1961, to the Papago Tribal Chairman, the Superintendent wrote "This office is willing to redeposit the money and additional money in some other bank having Federal Deposit Insurance", and

WHEREAS, As of April 30, the deposit of these two amounts will leave a balance of \$2,523.97 in the District IIM account, which should be more than adequate to cover any expenses for the balance of the fiscal year, plus the amount of the probable budget for the 1961-2 fiscal year, even if no further revenue is received, and

WHEREAS, The members of the Chukut Kuk District Council considering this matter have been duly selected in accordance with District procedure, and its officers, who have been duly elected by the District Council, are Joseph Martin, Chairman, Archie Hendricks, Secretary, and Ramon Chavez, Treasurer.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE Papago Tribal Council that it approve the resolution of the Chukut Kuk District Council, ~~and that it recommend that Chukut Kuk District Council,~~ and that it recommend that Chukut Kuk District funds be deposited in the manner above outlined.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on May 5, 1961, with a vote of 19 for, and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (c), and (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject of the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
