

RESOLUTIONS  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. No. 1171

WHEREAS, On June 3, 1960, the Tribal Council passed Resolution 1113 approving the appointment of K. N. Garard, Route 2, Box 428X, Scottsdale, Arizona as consulting mining engineer until June 30, 1961, on a time and expense basis, to be paid from \$5,000 set up in the budget for that purpose, and

WHEREAS, The Council wishes to reappoint Mr. Garard for the 1962 Fiscal year ending June 30, 1962, and has set up \$3,000 in the 1962 Fiscal year budget to pay him for actual services rendered and expenses incurred.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY The Papago Tribal Council that K. N. Garard be employed for the fiscal year 1962 as consulting mining engineer for the Papago Tribe on a time and expense basis, and that the Chairman of the Papago Tribal Council be authorized to sign a contract with Mr. Garard containing the same provisions as previous contract with him, except it shall state that payments to him shall not exceed \$3,000 for the year, unless specifically authorized by the Tribal Council and approved by the Bureau of Indian Affairs

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on June 2, 1961, with a vote of 21 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) and (h), Article V, of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
