OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. No. 1175

WHEREAS, The Chairman of the Papago Tribal Council has requested per diem of \$175.00 needed for round trip rail transportation, board and lodging, and incidental expenses, to attend the American Indian Conference in Chicago from June 13-20, and

WHEREAS, The Council believes this conference is important enough so that the Papago Tribe should be officially represented.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY The Papago Tribal Council that it appoint Enos J. Francisco, Chairman of the Papago Tribal Council; as the official delegate of the Papago Tribe to the American Indian Conference in Chicago, and that it authorize per diem of \$175.00 for transportation, board and lodging, and other necessary expenses, so he can attend.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on June 2, 1961, with a vote of 18 for, 0 against, and 3 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by section 3, Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 18, 1934 (Stat1984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
