

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1178

WHEREAS, Joe C. Juan of Chuichu has started procedure in the Tribal Court to adopt as his son Frederick Leo Juan, whose mother was Della Juan and who died in 1956, Della Juan being 4/4 Papago and listed on the 1939 Roll, and the 1940 Census Roll as Number 1176, and

WHEREAS, The father is Valentine Lucero, a Pueblo Indian from New Mexico, whose whereabouts are unknown, and

WHEREAS, Frederick Leo Juan was born on February 23, 1947, in the Indian Hospital at Sacaton, Arizona and so has not been enrolled as a member of the Papago Tribe because he was born off the Papago Reservation, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council has the authority to adopt Frederick Leo Juan as a member of the Tribe in accordance with Article II Section 1 (b) of the Papago Constitution which provides that the Council shall have power to adopt all children born outside of the Reservation, who are the offspring of members, and are one-half or more Indian Blood.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY The Papago Tribal Council that it adopt Frederick Leo Juan as a member of the Papago Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on June 30, 1961 with a vote of 18 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article II of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984) Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
