

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1182

WHEREAS, The Schuk Toak District Council met on May 21, 1961 and approved the following budget to cover expenses for engine and well repair in the villages, for the purchase of gasoline, and for other expenses which the villages may consider necessary, and

WHEREAS, The Schuk Toak District had \$10,035.43 in its District account on June 30, 1961, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Schuk Toak District Budget for the 1962 fiscal year be approved as follows:

Santa Rosa Village	-	\$ 400.00
Pan Tak	-	400.00
San Pedro	-	400.00
Fresnal Village	-	400.00
Crow Hang	-	400.00
Sil Nakya	-	400.00
Comobabi	-	400.00
Queen's Well	-	400.00
Garcia Ranch	-	400.00

Plus \$250.00 to cover Insurance, license and repairs for truck.

The District has decided to continue dividing the money for the budget so it will spent equally among the villages in the District, and when it does not work out satisfactorily, a new way of setting up the budget will be considered.

It is understood that the money spent will be used for the needs of the villages named, and any amount not used will be considered as remaining a part of the District account.

José L. Francisco is authorized to approve in writing any requests for expenditures by the villages.

Passed at a meeting held May 21, 1961, at which a quorum was present, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against.

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED BY the Papago Council that the Budget submitted by the Schuk Toak District be approved.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on August 4, 1961, with a vote of 19 for and 2 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3 (a) and (h)
