

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1184

WHEREAS, The Sells District had \$1,515.32 in its District account on June 30, 1961; and

WHEREAS, the Sells District Council unanimously approved the following budget at a meeting held July 15, 1961, at which a quorum was present;

\$400.00 for Big Fields, San Luis, Iron Stand, and Nolic, to be used for Gas and Oil for Well operation, fence repair, and windmill repair.

\$300.00 For Cowlic to be used fixing the Charco.

\$300.00 for Sells village to be used for fixing the District fence.

\$1,000.00

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE Papago Tribal Council that it approve the above budget of the Sells District.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on August 4, 1961, with a vote of 21 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3 (a) and (h) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 21, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
