

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1188

WHEREAS, the present Vice-Chairman of the Papago Tribal Council is not bonded and cannot be bonded, therefore, he cannot be permitted to exercise any authority in tribal fiscal affairs, and

WHEREAS, the Agency Superintendent of the Papago Agency suggested that the Tribal Council pass a resolution to authorize the Treasurer or other bonded official to exercise in tribal fiscal affairs in the absence of the Chairman, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council at its meeting August 4, 1961, decided to authorize Raymond Segundo who is bonded to handle tribal fiscal affairs when necessary.

THEREFORE; LET IT BE RESOLVED By the Papago Tribal Council that Raymond Segundo Tribal Treasurer be authorized to handle tribal fiscal affairs in the absence of the Chairman.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on August 4, 1961, with a vote of 21 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (e) Article V, of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984). Said Resolution is affective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
