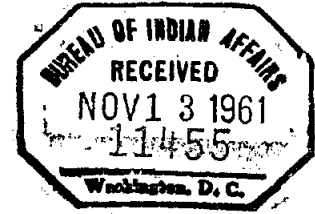


RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL



RES. NO. 1197

WHEREAS, Application has been received by the Tribe from Indian Oasis School District No. 40, Sells, Arizona, to lease two parcels of land within the Agency compound for a term of 25 years with the option to renew for an additional 25 years, and

WHEREAS, Although the lands consisting of 12.23 acres are in the Agency reserve it was decided to make the Tribe the lessor to take care of certain technicalities, and

WHEREAS, The lands proposed for lease have thereon certain Government buildings and these are in the process of being transferred to the Tribe, and the lease will include the land as well as the buildings with the proviso that the buildings may be moved, altered or otherwise made use of by the lessee, and

WHEREAS, Any buildings surplus to the needs of the lessee will be turned back to the Tribe and all buildings remaining on the premises at the expiration of the lease will become the property of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, The Council is desirous of obtaining an agreement between the lessee and the Contractor in charge of the construction of the school to the effect that the Contractor will employ Papago skilled and unskilled labor on the project whenever and wherever possible,

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED That a lease of 25 years with the option to renew for an additional 25 years be granted to Indian Oasis School District No. 40 on lands referred to above for the construction of a school plant and quarters for the education of Papago children as well as other children in the school district; that the amount of One Dollar (\$1.00) be charged for the lease as benefits to be derived from the project by the Papago Tribe will off-set any monetary considerations, and that the agreement referred to above between the lessee and the Contractor be executed prior to, or simultaneously with, the lease.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on October 27, 1961, with a vote of 17 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (c) and (k), Article V, of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,

pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
