RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1201

WHEREAS, B. L. Gustafson has applied for permission to remove 4,300 tons of sand and gravel from a pit one mile west of Tracy's Store, and

WHEREAS, it will be to the benefit of the Papago Tribe and to the residents of the Reservation that this sand and gravel be removed.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that permission is hereby granted to the said B. L. Gustafson to remove the said sand and gravel from the pit one mile west of Tracy's store.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on October 27th, 1961, with a vote of 17 for, and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present; pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (b) and (c), Article V, of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
