

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1205

WHEREAS, The Papago Indian Agency has made an application for a long term lease at Santa Rosa Ranch for a parcel of land described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is located due North 1750 feet from Southwest corner of section 18, T. 15.S., R. 7 E., Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona, thence east for a distance of 300 feet; thence south 589.9 feet; thence east 550 feet to point of beginning, containing 11.51 acres,

and

WHEREAS, The applicant proposes to construct new school building and living quarters for education personnel on the land, and

WHEREAS, A new school has been needed for a long time at the site and will be of great benefit for the education of the children in the district.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, By the Papago Council that a lease of fifty years on lands described above for the construction of a school plant; that the amount of One Dollar (\$1.00) be charged for the lease as benefits to be derived from the project by the Papago Tribe will off-set any monetary consideration.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on October 27th, 1961, with a vote of 17 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the council by Section 2 (c) and (k), Article V, of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
