

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1216

WHEREAS, Paul Hendricks left his position as Assistant Manager of the Papago Tribal Herd sometime prior to December 15th, 1961, without giving any previous notice to the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the contract between Paul Hendricks and the Tribe on his employment in the position provided that Hendricks should give not less than 30 days advance of termination of his employment, and

WHEREAS, Hendricks had take-home pay in the amount of \$80.63 due him on December 15th, 1961, and the Tribal Officers withheld payment of this amount to Hendricks until the matter could be submitted to the Tribal Council for consideration and disposition.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby authorizes, orders and approves payment to Paul Hendricks of this take-home pay in the amount of \$80.63.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on March 2, 1962, with a vote of 20 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution ratified on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
