

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1217

WHEREAS, in December 1956 the Papago Tribe granted a permit to the United States of America to use without cost the Sells Airport, and

WHEREAS, this permit expired in December 1961 and the U. S. Government has no further use for the said Sells Airport, and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Government is desirous of obtaining a General Release from the Tribe, releasing the Government from all claims for rental and from all other claims arising out of the use of the property.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, That the Papago Tribal Council hereby authorizes and empowers the Tribal Chairman and the Tribal Secretary to execute a General Release in favor of the United States of America, releasing the Government from all claims for rental of the Sells Airport and from all other and further claims arising out of the use of the Sells Airport by the U. S. Government.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on March 2, 1962 with a vote of 19 for and 0 against, and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution ratified on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 964), pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
