PAPAGO COUNCIL

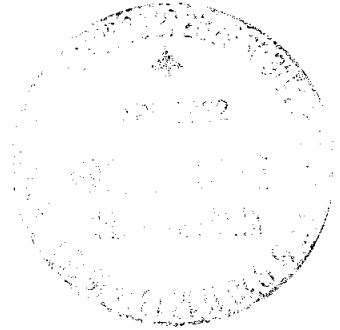
RES. NO. 1227

WHEREAS, in January 1962, at a regular meeting, at which a quorum was present, the Sif Oidak District Council passed a resolution authorizing that the people in the Village of Kohatk in the Sif Oidak District be repaid for the money they had expended on pump repairs in the Village during the years of 1959, 1960 and 1961, and

WHEREAS, the matter has been considered by the Papago Tribal Council and the Council feels that it is both just and equitable that these people in Kohatk be repaid for these moneys expended.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby authorizes and approves repayment to the people of Kohatk for moneys expended on pump repairs in 1959, 1960 and 1961, these expenditures being itemized as follows:

July 3, 1959	\$ 55.00
July 7, 1960	48.00
April 13, 1961	65.00
April 17, 1961--rod, re- pair pumps, and leather	5.45
Labor	18.85
Tax	.16
1960--total amount of gasoline purchased	59.20

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on April 6, 1962, with a vote of 20 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
