

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1230

WHEREAS, Felipe C. Aguilar of Tucson, Arizona, has applied for a lease of one acre of land for a period of 5 years in the Sells District north of State Highway 86 and adjacent to the western boundary line of land now under lease to the Sells Coffee Shop, and

WHEREAS, the said land will be used by the said Felipe C. Aguilar to park a trailer which will serve as an office for the livestock buying operations being conducted by the applicant, and

WHEREAS, the Resolutions of the Papago Tribe provide that land shall be rented at \$75 per acre or a fraction of an acre, and

WHEREAS, the Sells District Council has duly approved this application.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council hereby authorizes and approves the granting of a lease of one acre of land as described above for a period of 5 years at an annual rental of \$75.00 to the said Felipe C. Aguilar, that the lands shall be used for the purposes above set forth, that the annual rental shall be paid in advance on or before July 1, 1962 and each year thereafter, and that the rental shall be prorated for the period up to June 30, 1962.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on May 4, 1962, with a vote of 20 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (c), Section 3 (e) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
