

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1231

WHEREAS, Pete Aguirre, doing business as Sells Coffee Shop and Garage, of Sells has applied for a lease of the premises now occupied by him and consisting of four acres of land, and

WHEREAS, the present lease of the property will expire on June 30, 1962, and

WHEREAS, the Resolutions of the Papago Tribe provide that such land shall be rented at the rate of \$75 per acre per year, and

WHEREAS, under the current lease the tenant has the right to equip and use a well located on the leased lands, and this provision is to continue under the new lease, and

WHEREAS, the new lease is to be for a period of 5 years, commencing on July 1, 1962, and this application has been approved by the Sells District Council, and the said annual rental shall be paid in advance.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby authorizes and approves the granting of the said lease to the said Pete Aguirre for a period of 5 years, at an annual rental of \$75 per acre payable in advance commencing on July 1, 1962, covering the said land above described, with the tenant continuing to have the right to equip and use a well located on the leased land, and with all of the terms of the new lease to be the same in the present lease of the premises with the exception of changes herein set forth.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on May 4, 1962, with a vote of 20 for, and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (c), Section 3 (e), and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
