RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1232

WHEREAS, Taylor Construction Company, No. 4439 Romero Road, Tucson, Arizona, has applied for permission to remove dirt from two locations in the Sells District, the first location at a spot where the dirt is already excavated and the second location at a spot which was formerly a wash, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council is of the opinion that 7 cents per cubic yard would be a fair and reasonable price for such dirt, and

WHEREAS, the Sells District Council has approved such permission to the said Taylor Construction Company for the removal of the said dirt at the rate of 7 cents per cubic yard from the two locations above-named.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council hereby grants permission to the said Taylor Construction Company to remove the said dirt from the two locations above-named at a rate of 7 cents per subic yard.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on May 4, 1962, with a vote of 20 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (c) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratifed by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
