

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1233

WHEREAS, John Eberling, doing business as Eberling Ready-Mix, of Welton, Arizona, has applied to the Papago Tribal Council for a lease of one acre of land located in the Village of Sells in the Sells District, said land being in the rear of the Papago Trading Post building and near the Papago Tribal Warehouse, and

WHEREAS, the Resolutions of the Papago Tribal Council provide that such land shall be leased at the rate of \$75 per acre per year, commencing with the fiscal year on July 1st, and pro rata up to July 1st, and

WHEREAS, the Sells District Council has approved the granting of this lease, the land to be used to mix concrete in connection with the building of the new Sells District School.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council hereby authorizes and approves the granting of a lease of one acre as described above for a period of 1 year, commencing on April 9th, 1962, at an annual rental of \$75 to the said John Eberling, that the lands shall be used for the purposes above set forth, that the annual rental shall be paid in advance on or before July 1, 1962, and that the rental shall be pre-rated for the period up to June 30, 1962.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on May 4, 1962, with a vote of 20 for, and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (c), Section 3 (e) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
