

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1234

WHEREAS, John Eberling, doing business as Eberling Ready-Mix, of Welton, Arizona, has applied for permission to remove sand and gravel from a wash near the Sells Indian Hospital in Sells, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that 7 cents per cubic yard would be a fair and reasonable price for such sand and gravel, and

WHEREAS, the Sells District Council has approved the granting of a permit for the removal of said sand and gravel, the sand and gravel to be used in connection with the building of the new Sells District School.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council hereby grants permission to the said John Eberling to remove the said sand and gravel from the location above-named at a rate of 7 cents per cubic yard, the said sand and gravel to be used in connection with the new Sells District School.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on May 4, 1962, with a vote of 20 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (c) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
