

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1236

WHEREAS, On January 9, 1962, at a regular meeting, at which a quorum was present, the Vaya Chin, Kaka, Ventana Cattle Association approved a budget for the fiscal year 1962 and submitted it to the Hickiwan District Council, and

WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council has approved such budget, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the Cattle Association.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council hereby approves, ratifies and confirms the Vaya Chin, Kaka, Ventana Cattle Association budget for the 1962 fiscal year as follows:

The Association has a balance of \$2,117.93 in its IIM Account

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, the President, Vice-President or Secretary-Treasurer of the Vaya Chin, Kaka, Ventana Cattle Association be permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on May 4, 1962, with a vote of 20 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of

June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
