

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1238

WHEREAS, Paul Hinshaw of Casa Grande, Arizona has applied to the Papago Tribal Council for permission to remove Opalite rock from an area in the north end of Tat Momali Mountain in the Sif Oidak District, and

WHEREAS, the permit is to be for a period of 5 years and it is the opinion of the Council that a charge of 40 cents per ton for the material removed would be a fair and reasonable price, and

WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council has approved the permit to remove the said Opalite rock.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council hereby grants permission to the said Paul Hinshaw to remove the said Opalite rock from the location above-named at a rate of 40 cents per ton for the material removed for a period of 5 years.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on May 4, 1962, with a vote of 17 for, 0 against, and 3 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (c) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
