## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1243

WHEREAS, Fidel Gutierre, No. 3646 South 8th Street, Tucson, has applied for a permit to operate as a peddler upon the Papage Reservation, and to sell water-melon, all kinds of fresh fruit, and soda pop, and

WHEREAS, it will be to the benefit of the Tribe and to the residents of the Reservation that such permit be granted, and

WHEREAS, the applicant has already obtained a Health Certificate from the Pima County Health Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that a peddler's permit be issued forthwith to the said Fidel Gutierre to operate as a peddler on and through the Papago Reservation and to sell only the items of food and drink mentioned herein.

The feregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on June 1st, 1962, with a vete of 19 fer, 0 against, and 1 net voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (e) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
