RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1245

WHEREAS, Edward J. Sullivan, Administrative Assistant to the Tribe, has applied for an increase in his salary from the present figure of \$5,000 per year plus \$1,000 expenses to \$6,000 per year plus \$1,000 expenses, and

WHEREAS, when Mr. Sullivan was interviewed for the position in September 1961 by the Selection Committee of the Association for Papago Affairs, it was the understanding between the members of the Committee and Mr. Sullivan that the starting salary would be \$5,000 plus \$1,000 expenses for the balance of the current fiscal year, and that it would be increased to \$6,000 plus \$1,000 expenses for the next fiscal year, in the event that his work was satisfactory and he remained on the job, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Sullivan's work has been entirely satisfactory, many new projects have been commenced and others have been continued, and the operation of the Tribal Office has been completely satisfactory, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Spicer and Mrs. Estrada of the Selection Committee have recently talked to the Tribal Chairman, have confirmed that this was the understanding about the salary, and have both requested that the salary be increased as indicated above.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby grants and approves an increase in the salary of the Administrative Assistant to the Tribe to \$6,000 per year plus \$1,000 expenses, commencing on July 1st, 1962, and that the Tribal Officers are herby authorized and empowered to enter into a contract of employment with the said Edward J. Sullivan for the period of one year at the increased salary figure.

THE foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on June 1st, 1962, with a vote of 15 for, O against, and 5 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its Approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
