WHEREAS, The Council has also considered the estimated income, which is as follows: Interest from Tribal funds in Treasury 4,500.00 Rents and License Fees--Trading Posts \$ 6,000.00 Peddling Permits 1,500.00 Cattle buying and miscellaneous permits 500.00 Hunting Permits 2,000.00 Miscellaneous land and building rentals 500.00 Agricultural leases 500.00 Mining 2,500.00 Miscellaneous Income 500.00 3% Sales Tax on Livestock 12,000.00 Miscellaneous Livestock Income 500.00 Scale fees 1,000.00 Law and Order Court Fines 8,000.00 - 4490 Rodeo Receipts 5,500.00 TOTAL ESTIMATED INCOME \$ 45,500.00 and

WHEREAS, The Council believes the budget has been carefully prepared and represents a reasonably accurate estimate of expanses it considers essential to the proper operation of Tribal Government, and believes the Income has been conservatively estimated, and

WHEREAS, Although the budget estimates for the past 2 fiscal years have provided for a large deficit, actually Income has substantially exceeded expenses both years, and the financial position of the Tribe has been improving slowly. Therefore, the Council approves the deficit estimated at \$ 27,020 for the 1963 fiscal year, with the understanding that if Income is not as much as expected, an effort will be made to reduce or eliminate authorized budget expenditures whenever possible, but the Council hopes that Income continues to exceed expenses as in the past two years.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED By the Papago Tribal Council that the Treasurer be authorized to sign purchase orders and vouchers in the amounts provided in the above budget against the properly designated accounts, and

LET IT FURTHER BE RESOLVED that inamench as approximately \$14,000 of the anticipated income will be sent to the Treasury and will have to be released to the Tribe by the Treasury, and inamench as expenses may exceed income by \$27,020, that the Council request the Superintendent to withdraw the sum of up to \$25,000 of available Tribal funds in the Treasury, as needed, to be placed in the Agency IIM account to the Tribal Council, PT-LA, in order to maintain a satisfactory working balance.

The foregoing Resolution was approved on June 1, 1962 duly enacted by a vote of 19 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe.
