RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL Inbal office Also Res. #1270

RES. NO. 1254

WHEREAS, at each monthly meeting many matters come before the Tribal Council where the amount of money involved is very small, and

WHEREAS, many matters come to the attention of the Tribal Chairman which require immediate action and where a delay until the following Council meeting would result in financial loss to the Person or persons presenting the matter, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is an important branch of the Papago government and should not be compelled to devote a part of its meeting time to the consideration of comparatively unimportant matters, and

WHEREAS, at each monthly meeting the Tribal Council considers a long agenda which requires the attention and the presence of the Councilmen long into the night of meeting day.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby orders and authorizes the Tribal Chairman to consider and determine all matters coming before him which involve the sum of \$100.00 and less, and that the decision and disposition of such matters by the Tribal Chairman shall be final.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that at the Council meeting immediately following such action and determination by the Tribal Chairman, the decision and disposition by the Tribal Chairman shall be announced to the Council.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 6, 1962, with a vote of 19 for, 0 against, and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f), Section 3 (a), and Section 3 (b) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
