

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1262

WHEREAS, Mountain States Telephone and Telegraph Company has applied for a right of way for a new telephone line from the north boundary of the Reservation to the Chidichu Village, a distance of 2.338 miles, and

WHEREAS, the telephone line will be of general benefit to the community by making communications available to the Papago Agency sub-offices as well as members of the Village who may wish to use the telephone, and

WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council has passed a resolution favoring the establishment of the right of way and fixing a price of \$5.00 per pole as compensation for the right of way.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby approves and authorizes the establishment of a telephone line by the Mountain States Telephone and Telegraph Company from the north boundary line on the Reservation to Chidichu Village, a distance of 2.338 miles with a price of \$ 5.00 per pole as compensation for the right of way, and that the income from the establishment of such line shall be divided equally between the Tribe and the Sif Oidak District.

THE foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on August 5, 1962, with a vote of 18 for, 0 against, and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (c), Section 3 (e), and Section 5 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe,
