

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1261

WHEREAS, General Motors Company has applied for a lease of Jackrabbit Dry Lake for a period of 1 year and will use the land as a testing and proving ground for automobiles, and

WHEREAS, the land is barren and sandy and is not suitable for use for any other purpose, and

WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council has approved the lease with the applicant to pay \$300.00 in advance as rental for the first 6 months of the year and \$50.00 per month thereafter if and when the premises are used any part of a month.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby authorizes and confirms a lease of Jackrabbit Dry Lake for a period of 1 year, the land to be used as a testing and proving ground for automobiles and the applicant to pay \$300.00 in advance as rental for the first 6 months of the year and \$50.00 per month thereafter if and when the premises are used any part of a month.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal officers are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a lease agreement with the applicant under the terms above set forth and under no further or other terms.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on August 3, 1962, with a vote of 13 for, 3 against, and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (c), Section 3 (e), and Section 3 (h), of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
