

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1989

WHEREAS, the Construction Division of the Bureau of Indian Affairs proposes to erect additional buildings at Kerwo School located in Gu Vo District, and

WHEREAS, in order to prepare the plans for such buildings it will be necessary to make a land survey, and

WHEREAS, the Gu Vo District Council has approved the making of such survey.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby authorizes and approves the making of a survey by the Bureau of Indian Affairs in order to erect additional buildings in the Kerwo School in the Gu Vo District, and that a survey team be permitted to enter the above-mentioned premises for such purpose.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on August 3, 1962, with a vote of 17 for, 0 against, and 2 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
