

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1262

WHEREAS, the District Budget of the Schuk Toak District for the 1963 fiscal year has been previously and on June 1, 1962, approved and adopted by the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the 1963 Budget of the Schuk Toak District Council contains no provision for the establishment of a District Fund to be used for various purposes throughout the District other than the direct appropriations to the Villages of the District, and

WHEREAS, the District Council is of the opinion that the sum of \$500.00 is a proper and sufficient fund to be set aside and established to be used for various purposes throughout the District, and the District Council has approved the setting aside of such sum for such purpose.


NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council hereby orders and directs that the Schuk Toak District Budget be amended to include the establishment of a fund of \$500.00 to be used for various purposes throughout the District other than the direct appropriations for the Villages of the District and other than the appropriation to cover insurance, license and repairs to the District Truck.


LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that, with the exception of this special fund of \$500.00, the Tribal Council re-approves and re-affirms the 1963 fiscal year Budget as Previously approved by the Council on June 1, 1962.

LET IT BE STILL FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Treasurer of the Schuk Toak District Council or his duly authorized representative be permitted to sign purchase orders for purchases and for other purposes where applicable from this special fund of \$500.00 in the amounts specified.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on September 14th, 1962, with a vote of 18 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
