

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1268

WHEREAS, at a meeting held September 13, 1962, at which a quorum was present, the Sif Oidak District Council approved a Budget for the 1963 fiscal year and has submitted it to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed Budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the Papago Tribal Council that the Sif Oidak District Budget for the 1963 fiscal year be approved as follows:

Gasoline, Oil, Pump Repairs, Corral fixtures, Medicine for Livestock, Feed for Livestock, Groceries for Cowboys, and Stationery	\$ 1,500.00
Fixing of Boundary Line Fence around the District	1,000.00
All other General Purposes and Needs of the District	<u>500.00</u>
	\$3,000.00

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Sif Oidak District Council or his duly authorized representative be permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on September 14, 1962, with a vote of 20 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
