## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1270

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council at its meeting on July 6, 1962, adopted Resolution No. 1254 which provided that the Papago Tribal Chairman should consider and determine all matters coming before him which involve the sum of \$100.00 or less, and that the decision and disposition of such matters by the Tribal Chairman should be final, and that at the Council meeting immediately following such action and determination by the Tribal Chairman the decision and disposition by the Tribal Chairman should be announced to the Council, and

WHEREAS, in approving the said Resolution, the authorized representative of the Papago Indian Agency signed the Resolution "for the Superintendent" rather than as " Acting Superintendent", the latter being the correct form of signature, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council had previously and its July 6, 1962 meeting had considered this matter and had finally approved the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby re-orders and reauthorizes the Tribal Chairman to consider and determine all matters coming before him which involve the sum of \$100.00 or less, and that the decision and disposition of such matters by the Tribal Chairman shall be final.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that at the Council meeting immediately following such action and determination by the Tribal Chairman, the decision and disposition by the Tribal Chairman shall be announced to the Council.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on September 14, 1962, with a vote of 18 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
