RESOLUTION of the PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1273

WHEREAS, at a meeting held June 9th, 1962, at which a quorum was present, the Sells District Council approved a Budget for the 1963 fiscal year and has submitted it to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed Budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the Papago Tribal Council that the Sells District Budget for the 1963 fiscal year be approved as follows:

The Sells District had \$1,494.83 in its District Account on June 9, 1962.

\$500.00 -- for Big Fields and North Villages to be used for whatever purposes the Villages consider necessary.

\$300.00--for Sells to be used for whatever purpose the Village considers necessary.

\$300.00-for Coulic to be used for whatever purpose the Villages considers necessary.

\$1,100.00----TOTAL

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary-Treasurer of the Sells District Council or his authorized representative be permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on October 12th, 1962, with a vote of 19 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
