RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1274

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has previously appointed a Tribal Committee on Pronomic Redevelopment, and this Committee has conferred on many occasions over the past several months with representatives of the University of Arizona and among themselves, concerning the drafting of a Provisional Overall Economic Development Plan, and

WHEREAS, This Provisional Plan is now in final draft form and has previously been presented to the members of the Papago Tribal Council for additions, deletions, comments and suggestions, and

WHEREAS, all of these additions, deletions, comments and suggestions have been embodied, incorporated and absorbed into the final draft plan of the Provisional Plan, and

WHEREAS, the members of the Papago Tribal Council have considered and studied the Provisional Plan for the past several weeks, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that the said Provisional Plan meets the economic needs of the Papago Tribe and provides for certain projects and construction which will eventually result in the formation of work jobs for the Papago people and will greatly enhance and improve the economic condition of the Tribe members.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council hereby approves, ratifies and adopts the said Provisional Plan in its entirety, and requests and urges the proper authorities to proceed to activate the said Provisional Plan and to follow through on the many projects and construction outlined in the said Provisional Plan.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on October 12, 1962, with a vote of 15 for, 0 against, and 3 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (h) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
