RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1284

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council, at its October 12, 1962 meeting adopted a motion that the Superintendent and personnel of the Papago Indian Agency be allowed not more than one hour at each Council meeting to present their reports to the Council, and that they come to the meeting prepared to present such reports, and

WHEREAS, The members of the Council have since considered this matter and are now of the opinion that these reports of the Superintendent and personnel have proven to be of great benefit and value to the Papago Tribe and its members, and

WHEREAS, during the course of Tribal Council meetings many questions arise which can only be properly and correctly answered by the Superintendent and Agency personnel, and the Council members realize that the Papago Agency was established to assist and counsel the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Council now believes that no time limit should be set upon the presentation of these reports to the Council, and that the Superintendent and personnel should have as much time for such reports as they alone deem necessary, and that they should present such reports in Council meetings whenever they feel the subject matter involved is for the improvement and benefit of the Tribe and its members.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby cancels, annuls and revokes its previous action of the October 12, 1962 meeting concerning the appearance of the Superintendent and Agency personnel at Tribal Council meetings.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby extends an invitation to the Superintendent and his personnel to report to the Council at each and every meeting when, in their judgment, they wish to report to the Council on any matter or subject.

LET IT BE STILL FURTHER RESOLVED, that, in addition hereto, the Council will invite the Superintendent and Agency personnel to appear and report at Council meeting whenever the Council deems such appearance necessary.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on December 7, 1962, with a vote of 17 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By- Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
