## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1285

WHEREAS, the Department of the Navy, Bureau of Yards and Docks, has applied for a lease of one acre of land in the Sif Oidak District for one year at a rental per care of \$75 a year, and

WHEREAS, the land desired is located about one mile north of the Lake Shore mine turnoff along the west side of the Chuichu-Santa Rosa Road, and will be used to place a radio receiver van trailer periodically for periods of 10 days at a time and tests will be conducted by a crew of 4 men, and

WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council has passed a resolution approving said lease and said terms in full.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council hereby approves and confirms the lease of the above-described land to the Department of the Navy, Bureau of Yards and Docks, consisting of one acre of land for one year at an annual rental of \$75 per acre, the land to be used for the above-described purposes.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on January 4, 1963, with a vote of 21 for, 0 against, and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (c) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
