RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1290

WHEREAS, from time to time in the past, on Resolution of the Council, Mrs. Elizabeth Estrada, Tribal Director of Arts and Crafts, has received from the Tribe advances of money to be used for the purchase of Papago baskets, and these baskets are later sold at county fairs, rodeos, art festivals and similar occasions, and

WHEREAS, for the past three or four months Mrs. Estrada has been buying baskets, mostly for sale at the Pima County Fair this month, Indian Night at the Sunday Evening Forum in Tucson this month, the visit to Sells of the A.A.W. Women this month, and similar events, and has disbursed all of the money advanced to her by the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Estrada, in the purchase of these baskets, has also disbursed \$1,500 of her own money.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby orders and directs that the sum of \$1,500.00 in cash be immediately repaid to Mrs. Estrada to compensate her for the advancement of this amount in her own funds which have been disbursed for the purchase of the baskets mentioned above, and the Papago Tribal Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to make such payment immediately to Mrs. Estrada.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on March 1, 1963, with a vote of 21 for, 0 against, and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (1) and Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
