RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. <u>1300</u>

WHEREAS, Thomas Throssell was appointed Tribal Livestock Inspector on January 4, 1952 by virtue of Tribal Council Resolution No. 593, and

WHEREAS, during the period from the time of the appointment until the present time time increase in the wage rate of the said Thomas Throssell has been slight, and

WHEREAS, under the present salary arrangement, the Papago Tribe pays the said Thomas Throssell 79 cents per hour and at the same time the State of Arizona, for which the said Thomas Throssell is also employed as Livestock Inspector, pays his 87 cents per hour, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council is of the opinion that during the past eleven years since his appointment the said Thomas Throssell has fulfilled all of his duties for the Tribe in a satisfactory and competent manner, and the Papago Council believes that at this time the said Thomas Throssell is entitled to an increase in his wage rate received him from the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, provision for such increase of pay is made in the 1963 fiscal year Budget of the Tribal Livestock Inspector's Office.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT HE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby orders and directs that the hourly wage rate paid to the said Thomas Throssell by the Papago Tribe be increased from 79 cents per hour to \$1.00 per hour and that said increase become effective as soon as this Resolution is approved by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on May 3, 1963, with a vote of 19 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
