## RESOLUTION

## OF THE

## PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1301

WHEREAS, President John F. Kennedy some time ago ordered that the minimum wage rate to be paid by employers to employees throughout the United States is to be \$1.25 per hour, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council is desirous of complying with this order of the President insofar as the employees of the Papago Tribe are concerned, and

WHEREAS, the position of Court Clerk in the Tribal law & Order Department is the only position within the employ of the Papago Tribe presently paying a wage of less than the federal minimum wage rate, the said position presently paying 98 cents per hour and being filled at this time by Miss Philomena Manuel, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council is interested in paying a decent, fair, living wage to all employees of the Papago Tribe, and

WHEREAS, provision for such increase of pay is made in the 1963 fiscal year Budget of the Tribal Law & Order Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby orders and directs that the salary of Miss Philomena Manuel as Court Clerk in the Law & Order Department be, and the same hereby is, increased from 98 cents per hour to \$1.25 per hour, to become effective on approval of this Resolution by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on May 3, 1963, with a vote of 18 for, 0 against, and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
